During April, we had 154 medical visits, 17 telehealth visits, and 49 dental visits. We had 112 student volunteers representing medicine, pharmacy, nursing, dental, OT/PT, and undergraduate institutions with over 702 individual volunteer hours.


GROCERY STORE TOURS
